5. Introductions	 Guest: Alexis Carter, Director, Human Resources Operations & Employee Services, Alexis shared information and and updates on the transition to SISC. Need to treat this as completely new benefits, let your physicians and pharmacy know that you have new benefits so they can verify your new coverage. It was a smoother transition for the Kaiser clients versus Blue Shield. HR is still working on establishing a relationship with Blue Shield and Navitus for prescriptions. Same goes with dental and vision, it's a new insurance, let your doctor's office know about your new coverage. Many of these physician's offices are running under your old insurance. Contact HR if there information such as DOB or social security is wrong. A member shared information about having to call Navitus not Blue Shield if you are having issues with prescription coverage. Mark will be sending out information on this to members.

Comment made and noted about punctuation and spelling. Robert shared information with members on the creation of the resolution. Mark shared how the process for creating, submitting and the approval process works. Q: Has Dr. Scroggins provided feedback on this? A: No, we have not heard back from him yet. Robert plans on sharing it with him. Robert and Sandra will meet with Faculty Association and ask for their support on the resolution. There are many Community Colleges that are not happy with the new funding formula. Also, Rosa Ascencio is part of the CSEA Community College Committee and will be encouraging other chapters to support this resolution. Corrections to the resolution will be made by Robert. Vote to approve the resolution presented and amended, motion passes.
